

Traffic group report for January 2018

We have been advised that our application for a substantive bid for funding to provide build-outs in the London Road was unsuccessful.

Work is still 'in progress' to provide signage directing MOD vehicles away from the village.

The SIDs are currently deployed, one in the London Road monitoring westbound traffic, the other on the A360 (near the Chitterne Road junction) monitoring southbound traffic. It was hoped to realign the SID in the London Road to monitor eastbound traffic at the end of the holiday but, on attending the unit, I felt the westbound traffic was more of a problem.

Normally the SIDs are deployed as a pair but one of the 30MPH speed limit signs on the A360 was knocked down some weeks ago and is awaiting replacement by Wiltshire Council, I felt that the presence of a SID may assist in reducing traffic speed.
