

SHREWTON MILITARY LIAISON REPORT - 7 February 2018

MOD Road Signs

Highways at Wiltshire Council have approved the design of the military vehicle road signs to go up around Shrewton. Tom from Landmarc (and Traffic Working Group) has indicated the purchase order has been approved for the signs to be made. We are waiting for the actual delivery date. In the meantime, I shall contact Highways again to try and get their assistance to erect the signs once available.

Army Basing Programme

At the last Amesbury Board on 18 Jan 18, Lovell indicated they had been awarded the contract on 23 Nov 17 to build 917 Service Families Accommodation (SFA) required at three sites across Salisbury Plain Training Area with works now well underway. They said to me they would not be affected in this by the collapse of the company Carillion.

To allow the development of the Bulford SFA site, where 225 houses will be built, two road closures will be required. This is to allow Chasetown Civil Engineering Ltd to undertake works for a new entrance into the site and to connect utilities. The first closure will start on 19 Feb 18 and will reopen on 19 Mar 18. The road will close from A3028 Double Hedges, Bulford; from it's junction with Amesbury Road for a distance of approximately 1.42km in a westerly direction.

The alternative route will be via Amesbury Road - Bulford Road - Bulford Droveaway - Milston Road - Salisbury Road - A3028 Double Hedges (unaffected length) and vice versa. Access will still be available from Bulford Road along Double Hedges Road to gain entry to the playing field and dog walking area.

The second closure will take place between 19 Mar 18 and 15 Apr 18 outside the Canadian Estate.
