Chatterbox

The Chatterbox (baby and toddlers) Group meets on a Wednesday morning at the Village Hall during school term.

Young Hearts

The Young Hearts Group (7 to 11 year olds) meet on a Friday at the Shrewton Methodist Church. They re-start in March 2018.

Shrewton Youth Club

The Shrewton Youth Club (11 to 16 year olds) meet on a Wednesday night at the Village Hall/ Recreation Ground. The Club has a new leader, Abbie Edwards.

Shrewton Youth Club Extra

Shrewton Youth Club currently caters for those ages 11-16. This is proving popular and whilst we have seen a steady increase in the 11-13-year olds, the older group prove to be harder to engage. There is also less opportunities in the village as they get older with guides stopping at 16 and scouts at 15.

The Youth Club will add an extra monthly session for the 14-17-year olds. This will provide a variation to the normal Youth Club night. Rather than it being activity led, it will be led by the young people's needs and requirements, with the hope that they will plan and organize anything they want to do with adult support if needed. The pilot sessions have been funded by the Amesbury Area Board and will be started once the new Youth Leader is settled in properly.

Local Youth Network (LYN)

There was an Amesbury Area Board LYN Event at Avon Valley College on 10 January 2018. This was attended by 80 young people from Avon Valley College in Durrington and Stonehenge School in Amesbury.
