

Chair's report for March 2018

On 7 March I gave a short presentation to one member from the International Council on Monuments and Sites (ICOMOS) and United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) – one person from each organisation - on Shrewton Parish Council's views (and those of the wider community) of the proposal to tunnel the A303 in the Stonehenge area.

This was in response to the desire of ICOMOS to further understand Highways England's plans for the tunnel and to gain the opinions of stakeholders, including those who live locally and who are most affected by the A303.

This is not part of the Highways England consultation and I urge everybody to provide feedback to Highways England on the scheme – if we don't others will and their views may not be to our advantage.
