

Chair's report for October 2018

September has been a quite month for the Parish Council due to holiday absences, however members have maintained contact with issues despite being away and I would like to thank all concerned.

Traffic remains a major issue for our village, especially the speed of traffic in the London Road. Following comments made at a recent Community Area Traffic Group meeting about the lack of visibility of the street lamps (which denote a 30MPH speed limit) in the London Road the vegetation has been cut back which makes the lamp posts more visible; the Speed Indicator Device traffic logging will show whether this makes any difference.
