

# A303 Community Forum meeting

7pm – 8.30pm, Thursday 25 October 2018 at Holiday Inn, Amesbury

A well attended meeting with representatives from neighbouring parishes and interested organisations and groups and a new chairman.

The recent consultation had over 50% more responses compared to the 2007 one - mostly resulting from a English Heritage initiative. Some items of note.

1. Winterbourne Stoke viaduct parapet - supported.
2. Green bridge - wider version preferred.
3. Western approach - green banks preferred by majority but argument made in favour of vertical walls.
4. Western tunnel entrance - fully grasses canopy.
5. No new byway 11-12 link.

All documents are online - massive data base

Application to get building has been submitted, first feedback expected in November, decision expected by spring 2020.

IMPORTANT SPC register as interested party.

Infrastructure work first - e.g, Rollestone “Corner”.

Main construction starts 2021 with priority on Countess flyover and Winterbourne Stoke viaduct.

Benefits to local area fro £150k “Designated funds” (search “Highways England) to support Legacy ideas e.g. path to the visitor centre.
