

## **Traffic group report for November 2018**

### **Military Vehicles on B3086**

Although signage has been deployed advising military drivers that they must not use the B3086 some military vehicles continue to do so. I have spoken with a member of SPTA and asked what can WE do to help keep these vehicles off the B3086. The response was that the signs are a bit small and drivers are not seeing them until it is too late. The suggestion was to provide more signage to the east of Rolleston Crossroads instructing military drivers to use the Southern Transit Route and to provide a sign opposite the Social Club instructing drivers to bear right at the mini-roundabout.

This suggestion has been put to the traffic working group, there was a mixed response, from already too much street furniture to 'fully agree'.

Since then (mid-October) a meeting has been arranged between some members of Shrewton Parish Council and the MOD at Larkhill, an update will be provided following this meeting.

### **A360**

White lines, including hatchings, have now been installed on the A360. Although simple in design the intention is to make the road appear more narrow thus reducing the sense of 'wide space' so encouraging drivers to slow down.

A pedestrian walkway has been marked between Highfield Rise and Catherine Court, whilst some drivers are respecting this and parking in a manner that leaves space for pedestrians it is a shame that there are others who are disregarding these markings. This situation will be monitored with a view to further measures if required.

### **More SIDs**

A spreadsheet has been circulated to members with the costings of three SID devices.
