

Chair's report for December 2018

In commemoration of the ending of the First World War commemorative trees have been planted at the cricket ground being developed at Nett Road. I would like to thank all those who gave their time to this memorial to those who gave their lives for our country.

A 'bus survey' was recently distributed to the village (with Arrowhead magazine and the website). There were 11 responses; unfortunately there are not enough prospective passengers to make the re-introduction of a bus service between Shrewton and Amesbury a possibility. A breakdown of the responses will be provided at a later date.

Along with other Parish Councillors I met with the MOD at Larkhill on 14 November to discuss the issue of military vehicles, including those in excess of 3.5T laden weight, using Shrewton High Street and London Road. The MOD confirmed that standing orders prohibit MOD vehicles from using these roads and they can be reported; as well as the vehicle registration number it was requested that if possible a photograph be provided as evidence – an email address (yet to be decided) will be advertised for people to report errant vehicles.
