20/222 Planning Applications and appeals decided:

21/01728/FUL Construction of first floor over existing double garage for ancillary accommodation. Willow Garden, Tanners Lane, Shrewton, SP3 4JT

Cllr Hassett proposed no objections, seconded Cllr Lock, voting unanimous in favour.

21/02174/LBC Installation of a Stannah lift. The Old Vicarage, Maddington, Shrewton.

Cllr Berry proposed supporting, seconded Cllr Woodman, voting unanimous in favour.

21/01659/FUL Demolition of the existing redundant agricultural building and the erection
& **21/02527/LBC** of a single storey, one-bedroom annexe. The Grange, Maddington Street, Shrewton, Salisbury, Wiltshire, SP3 4JL.

Cllr Pope proposed no objections provided it remains as ancillary use to the main house and remains part of the curtilage of the Grange and not sold off later as a separate entity, seconded Cllr Woodman, voting unanimous in favour.

20/10762/FUL Demolition of existing building and the erection of one detached dwelling (Use Revised plans Class C3), landscaping improvements and associated works. Barn at Fleming Farm Homanton Shrewton SP3 4ER.

Cllr Lock proposed supporting, seconded Cllr Hassett, voting unanimous in favour.

21/01193/LBC Replacement of five sash windows on frontal aspect of the house with handmade, like for like, single glazed windows (resubmission of 20/08606/LBC) Whiteways High Street Shrewton SP3 4DD.

Cllr Berry proposed supporting, seconded Cllr Flint, voting unanimous in favour.

21/02099/FUL Construction of a second storey over an existing single storey to the rear of the property. Replacement of the existing vertically hung tiles on all four elevations with insulated boards, rendered and painted light grey. Heatherbank The Hollow Shrewton SP3 4JY.

Cllr Flint proposed no objections, seconded Cllr Pope, voting five in favour, one abstaining and Cllr Lock ineligible to vote.
