

## **Shrewton Remembrance Day Parade – Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> November 2021** **Application for Temporary Road Closures – Consultation Letter**

Shrewton Parish Council would like to inform you that they intend to hold a parade on **Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> November 2021** to commemorate Remembrance Day.

**The Route:** The parade will march from Shrewton Sports and Social Club eastward along Maddington Street (A360) to the High Street (B3086) then along the High Street to St Mary's Church where it will fall out for the Remembrance Day Service. After the service, the parade will reform and march from St Mary's Church back to the Sports and Social Club. Road closed signs will be displayed for the duration of the two marches.

### **Timings:**

Maddington Street from Sports & Social Club will close at 10.35am – for approx. 5 minutes

High Street will close from 10.35am – 10.50am approx.

Return journey

High Street will close 11.50am approx. for 15 minutes approx.

Maddington Street will close at approx. 12noon for 5 minutes approx.

**Temporary Road Closure Order.** A Temporary Road Closure Order has been applied for under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, which will close the parade route for the times mentioned above.

**Alternative Routes.** The A360 will be closed for 5 minutes maximum, the B3086 15 minutes maximum. There are no suitable alternative routes so traffic will have to wait for the few minutes it takes for the parade to march each part of the route on both the outbound and return legs. Shrewton High Street can be avoided by eastbound A360 traffic continuing on the A360 to the Stonehenge Visitor Centre roundabout, turning left to Rollestone Crossroads and then right onto the Packway. Westbound traffic on the Packway can avoid Shrewton High Street by turning left at Rollestone Crossroads and then right at Stonehenge Visitor Centre roundabout onto the A360. There will be no diversion signs on this alternative route. Traffic trying to use Shrewton High Street will be controlled by marshals who will not allow any vehicles to pass the parade either from in front or behind.

All objections must include the name and address of the objector or they cannot be considered. Objectors have the right to request under the Data Protection Act 1998 that their name and address be withheld from public inspection or inclusion in any published report.

**Road Closure Notification Notice.** Following its approval, copies of the Temporary Road Closure Order will be displayed along the route and around Shrewton and neighbouring villages for at least the required legal minimum of four days prior to the event.

**Conclusion.** The Shrewton Remembrance Day parade has been an annual event for many years. Wiltshire County Council has determined that a Temporary Road Closure Order is essential to comply with the law. This will provide formal authorisation to close the roads for the duration of the event thus adding to the safety of all those taking part. Shrewton Parish Council apologises in advance for the inevitable inconvenience and disruption that will be caused by the parade.
